-Contend with my opponents, O LORD; fight against those who battle me. (*Psalm 35:1*)

-They pour out arrogant words; all workers of iniquity boast. (Psalm 94:4)

-For wicked and deceitful mouths are opened against me, speaking against me with lying tongues. (*Psalm 109:2*)

-Silence their lying lips— those proud and arrogant lips that accuse the godly. (*Psalm 31:18*)

-O Lord, confuse and confound their speech, for I see violence and strife in the city. (*Psalm 55:9*)

-Let them be confounded and put to shame that seek after my soul: let them be turned back and brought to confusion that devise my hurt. Let them be as chaff before the wind: and let the angel of the LORD chase them. (*Psalm 35:4-5*)

-Keep me from the traps they have set for me, from the snares of those who do wrong. (*Psalm 141:9*)

-I praise You Lord for delivering me from the hand of the wicked and redeeming me from the grasp of the violent. (*Jeremiah 15:21*)

-Lord God I praise You for delivering me from the snare of the fowler. (*Psalm 91:3*)

-Lord God, I praise You for contending with those who contend with me. For making my oppressors drunk on their own blood, as with wine. Then they will know Lord that you are my savior and redeemer. *(Isaiah 49:25-26)* -Teach them Lord, to have a fear of You. Deliver or where necessary, redeem them Lord, as your hand is not too short that it cannot save, nor is your ear to heavy that it cannot hear. Teach them Lord that those who fear you Lord shall lack nothing. (*Psalm 34:9, Isaiah 50:2, & Isaiah 59:1*)

-Lord God, I have kept your command to endure patiently. Show me mercy Lord and keep me from the hour of trial to test the inhabitants of the earth. (*Rev 3:10*)
